Patsy Petro was a local sports enthusiast who attended South Union High School, and supported local baseball teams in the area. A Pittsburgh Pirates Gold Club ticket salesman, he is credited with establishing Uniontown Day at Three Rivers Stadium and PNC Park, and with arranging for the Pirate Caravan to come to Uniontown. He enjoyed watching his grandsons play baseball and was a supporter of youth baseball teams. A lifelong fan of the Pittsburgh Pirates, Mr. Petro was the owner-operator of South Union Bus Lines. Following his retirement, he worked as a court bailiff for the late Judge William J. Franks.
