Scholarships Available for Uniontown Area High School Students:

- **New for 2021:** All applications are online. Students will complete their general biographic info on one Universal application. You will then see a list of scholarships you're eligible for based on the info you provide in the Universal Application. I've also made a list of scholarships you may be eligible for that you can use as a checklist.
 - In 2020, CFFC awarded over \$200,000 in scholarships to local students! To apply visit <http://www.cffayettepa.org/scholarships/>
 - **“Decline Opportunity”** is meant for applications that you have not started yet. It will appear on your dashboard as declined, but you can still go back and edit the questions in that part of the app AND SUBMIT IT. So it's not a permanent thing to choose Decline.
 - **“Abandon Request”** is more serious., The system will double check by opening a confirmation box to be sure you really want to abandon a request you've worked on. **ABANDON REQUEST is not reversible!** It will appear on the dashboard as Abandoned.
 - Pay careful attention to the essay prompt. There are about five different topics, so be sure you are answering the correct one. If the same essay question is used for multiple applications, then its automatically shared.
 - If a scholarship is based on “Financial Need”, you need to submit your Student Aid Report (SAR) from your FAFSA. The SAR contains your Expected Family Contribution (a required field on application)
 - Transcripts - Enter this email Courtney.baker@uasdraiders.org
 - Letter of Recommendation - You must chose one (only one) person to provide a recommendation for you. In the application portal, you will compose an email to that person and they will receive a request from CFFC. They will not be asked to upload a traditional letter. They will answer questions and share their comments in a text box.
 - CFFC recommends using Google Chrome.
 - ***Applications and all supporting documents are due online by March 26, 2021.***

Betty Bayne Barnes Scholarship Fund for Women

- Candidate must be a female resident of Fayette County, holding a GPA of 3.0 or higher, either planning to attend or attending a college or university.

Maurice M. Bortz & Bessie D. Rinehart Memorial Scholarship

- Candidate must attend Uniontown Area Senior High School or Laurel Highlands Senior High School.
- Candidate must have participated in little league baseball, basketball at the varsity level, intra-mural level, or church league level, and must have a strong desire to further their education.

Dr. Dennis F. Brestensky Scholarship Fund

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident attending or planning to attend Penn State University, Fayette – the Eberly Campus.
- Candidate must have a 3.3 GPA or higher and demonstrate financial need.
- Preference will be made to students pursuing a Bachelor's Degree.

Career and Technical Education Scholarship Fund

- Candidate must be a graduating senior from a technical program.
- Candidate must have a B average in both High School academics and technical program.
- Candidate must score Competent or Advanced on End of Program Assessment (NOCTI or NIMS)

Allen Craft Memorial Scholarship

- Candidate must be a graduating senior at Laurel Highlands High School or Uniontown Area High School, participated in sports during high school (although awards will not be limited to athletes), and hold an interest in community service.

Cupelli Family Scholarship

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident attending or planning to attend the University of Pittsburgh or West Virginia University as a full-time, degree seeking student.
- Candidate must hold a 3.0 GPA based on a 4.0 scale or maintain at least a 3.0 GPA while making progress toward a degree at the University of Pittsburgh or at West Virginia University.

Lulu A. Dudley Scholarship Fund

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident, show academic promise and financial need.

Robert E. and Elouise R. Eberly Scholarship Endowment

- Candidate must be a United States of America citizen, a Fayette County, PA resident and majoring in Nursing.

Fayette Young Professionals Scholarship Fund

- Candidate must be a Fayette County, PA resident, attending a high school in Fayette County.

Nancy Flanagan McManus Nursing Scholarship

- Candidate must be a female senior attending Uniontown High School with a minimum GPA of 3.25 and show financial need.
- Student must be planning to attend an accredited four year Bachelor of Science Nursing program.

Arthur and Millicent Gabriel Scholarship

- Candidate must be a high school senior attending Laurel Highlands High School, or Uniontown Area High School, holding a minimum GPA of 3.2 or higher and showing academic promise.
- The candidate must plan to major in a post-secondary education program in Science, Technology, Engineering or Math (STEM).

- This is a 4-year renewable scholarship. At the end of each year of college, the student must submit to the Community Foundation of Fayette County an Official College Transcript. In order to be eligible for renewal, the student must achieve a GPA of 2.75 or higher.

George M. and Anna Hochheimer Scholarship

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident, show academic promise and financial need.

Sergeant Eric Hull Advised and Memorial Scholarship Funds

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident, attending or planning to attend college. Preference will be given to Culinary Arts students, however all eligible candidates are encouraged to apply.

Alfred E. Jones & Anna B. Jones Scholarship

- Candidate must be a high school graduate from Fayette County planning to continue their education with post-secondary school study. Although preference will be given to those who have chosen to study nursing or art, areas that were of special interest to Anna B. and Alfred Jones, respectively, applications from students who seek to pursue courses of study in other fields are certainly welcomed.

Nancy Vance Jones Scholarship

- Candidate must be a female resident of Fayette County, with a strong academic record.
- A graduate or graduating senior of a Fayette County High School.
- Demonstrate a significant level of interest and involvement in community service.

Lillian's Legacy

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident planning to attend a 2 or 4 year post-secondary school. Consideration will be given to students demonstrating proven financial need and to minorities, but not necessary to receive the award.

Suzanne J. McMonagle Nursing Scholarship

- Candidate must be a Fayette County, PA resident pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) or must be a Registered Nurse (RN) pursuing a BSN.
- Preference will be given to Albert Gallatin High School seniors or graduates.
- This award is renewable for up to four years, if the candidate maintains a 2.75 GPA and is a student in good standing

Carl S. Micarelli Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Candidate must be a Fayette County student attending or planning to attend the following schools including, but not limited to, California University of PA, Carnegie Mellon University, Duquesne University, Indiana University of PA, University of Pittsburgh or West Virginia University.
- Student must be majoring in music, music education or jazz studies with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Frank L. Muzika Catholic War Veterans Scholarship

- * Must be a Uniontown Area High School senior and a relative of a Catholic War Veteran.

My Mother's Legacy

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident, pursuing a career in healthcare or the healing arts.

Zackery R. Nelson Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Candidate must be a Fayette County resident, holding a 3.0 GPA or higher, and planning to attend or attending any college, university or technical school. Adults wishing to continue their education are also eligible to apply.

Dr. Paul Pipik Fund for Study in the Health Sciences

- Candidate must be a high school senior, attending a Fayette County, PA high school, holding a GPA of 3.0. Applicant must be accepted to a post-secondary school, major in the field of health science and demonstrate financial need.

Helen Hulvey Scheggia Nursing Scholarship

- Candidate must be a high school senior or graduate of a Fayette County, PA high school pursuing a career in nursing.
- Candidate must maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA.

Wolford Swimmer Memorial Scholarship

- Candidate must be a Fayette County student either attending or planning to attend college.
- Candidate must hold a 3.0 GPA (based on a 4.0 GPA scale) and show financial need.

Dr. William C. Thomas, Jr. Perseverance Scholarship

- Candidate must be a Uniontown Area High School Senior holding a GPA of 2.75 or above on a 4.0 scale. Or, the student has received this award in previous years.
- If applicant has received this award previously, they must continually meet the criteria of being a full time college student, be in good standing, and maintain a GPA of 2.75 or above on a 4.0 scale.
- Candidate must participate in at least 4 hours of community service per month.
- Consideration will be given to students demonstrating the following, but not necessary to receive an award: proven financial need, students pursuing a medical field, minorities.

Darrell L. and Norma R. Uphold Family Scholarship

- Candidate must be a senior attending Uniontown Area High School that has attended UAHS his/her entire junior and senior years.
- Candidate must be planning to attend one of the following schools on a full-time basis: California University of PA, Penn State University, University of Pittsburgh, Westminster College, New Wilmington, PA or West Virginia University.

Mary Jane Dailey Wood Scholarship

- Candidate must be a high school senior from one of the following schools: Laurel Highlands High School, Uniontown, PA; Nelson County High School, Lovingston, VA; Regina Catholic High School, Warren, MI; Uniontown Area High School, Uniontown, PA; University High School, Morgantown, WV, Bridgeport High School, Bridgeport, WV; or Robert C. Byrd High School, Clarksburg, WV.
- Student must have between a 2.5 and 3.0 GPA, participate in sports and show financial need.

Edward T. Yezioro Memorial Scholarship

- Candidate must be a senior attending Uniontown Area High School and planning to major in education or secondary education.

As a Fayette County, you may also be eligible to receive an Eberly Family Scholarship. Ask your college's Financial Aid Office.
