As we look forward to the arrival of spring, I am excited to share information regarding an on-campus summer opportunity for your most talented students.

The Miami University Summer Scholars Program is an opportunity for academically talented rising high school juniors and seniors to spend two weeks on Miami's campus exploring a topic of their choice alongside our leading faculty and professional experts. The program offers students an insider's look at the college application process, with structured workshops focused on application essay writing, an introduction to financial aid and scholarships, and sessions on developing leadership skills. Participants who choose to apply to Miami will also receive priority consideration for Miami merit scholarships and the University's premier academic programs — the University Academic Scholars Program and the University Honors Program.

If you have students who would be interested in this opportunity, I hope you will encourage them to learn more about the Summer Scholars Program and apply. The University is pleased to offer a limited number of full scholarships for the Summer Scholars Program to academically talented students with financial need who apply and are accepted to the program.

As part of the application process, counselors will need to submit a letter of recommendation, as well as the applicant's most current transcript and a copy of any available test score reports. We will gladly accept ACT, SAT, PSAT, and PLAN scores; official score reports are not required. If you are submitting application materials on behalf of a student in need of financial assistance, you must also submit verification of the student's eligibility for free or reduced school lunch. All application materials can be submitted online and need to be received by May 1, 2018.
