STUDENT SCHEDULING 2020-2021

Students scheduling for the 2020-2021 school year will have two options:

**Incoming freshmen will not enter course requests in CSIU. Please see the 9th grade course request sheet for specific instructions.*

Online Course Requests

- Log on to <https://studentsis.csiu-technology.org/uasd>
 - Type in your user name. This is your existing student identification number.
 - Type in your password.
- You're logged in!
 - Click on the "Course Request" tab at the top of the page.
 - On the right side of the page click on "New Request".
 - Begin the Course Request Process be sure to follow the scheduling instructions for the selection of classes that are included on the back of this page.

1. From the "Department" drop-down menu, choose a department: for example "Language Arts"
2. From the "Course" drop-down menu, choose the course you wish to request: for example "AP Language"
3. Click "Save".
4. Continue choosing your courses until you have requested 8 total credits (7.5 for FCCTI students) for the 2020-2021 school year.
5. Students can email their counselor for specific advice. Your current teachers are also a great source for recommendations.
